

Feng Chia University International Student Admission FAQ

Q1: I have submitted the online application form and uploaded all the required documents; does it mean that I have finished the application procedure?

A1: Yes. You will receive an email notification to inform you we had received your application if you had handed in all the required documents, or you will receive an email for resubmit the documents.

Q2: I have only one copy of the original transcript, can I send a photocopy to you instead?

A2: Please send us the transcripts that are issued by your university. Usually students can apply for more transcripts or have the photocopies stamped in such office as the registration office at the school.

Q3: What is the Study plan? Is there any guideline offered?

A3: You have to state your motives and plans for study at FCU in the statement of Purpose, which is printed on a separate piece of paper, either in Chinese or in English. Length is not limited, and there is no guideline offered.

Q4: What is the status of my application?

A4: To check the status of your application, you will need to sign into your Application for Admission using your email address and date of birth. Go to the "inquire online" section and check for the status of your applications.

Q5: How many programs can I apply for?

A5: Each applicant can apply for up to **TWO** programs in one semester.

Q6: I am a Taiwan Scholarship winner, can I providing a letter from Ministry of Foreign Affairs as a bank statement? How do I prepare the financial statement when my major financial support will actually be the scholarships I am applying for at the same time?

A6: If your major financial support is Taiwan scholarships, and you can't submit other financial statement, then you don't have to submit the financial statement. However, if the admission result is influenced by not submitting the financial statement, it is applicant's own responsibility.

Q7: Regarding the tuition fee, do I have to pay for one semester or two semesters at a time?

A7: Students pay their tuition fee at the beginning of every semester.

Q8: Are there any scholarships or financial aids foreign applicants are eligible to apply for?

A8: The scholarships and financial aids are as follow:

- a. **FCU International Student Scholarship/Financial Aid.** Scholarships/financial aid are categorized as NT\$120,000, NT\$60,000 and living allowance for one academic year.

Q9: What qualifications do I need to apply for the New International Student Scholarship?

A9: Recipients of international students, students who have not received the Taiwan Scholarship may apply for this scholarship/financial aid.

Q10: What should I prepare for the application?

A10: Please check our admission book "What to Submit" for the required documents. Students who apply for English-taught programs, **English proficiency certificate (TOEFL, IELTS or TOEIC, may be waived if the applicant is a native speaker)** is required for scholarship/financial aid application. **Chinese proficiency certificate (TOECL or HSK, may be waived if the applicants is a native speaker)** is required for students who apply for Chinese-taught program.

Q11: How do I find out if I am eligible for scholarships?

A11: The awarded list will be posted on the admissions website according to the announced date in the admission handbook. Also, the applicants will be notice along with the admission notification. To find out if you are eligible for an award you will need to search for scholarships on the admissions website.

Q12: When will I receive the scholarship?

A12: Scholarships/financial aid are issued in two installments, one per semester. Scholarship funds are deposited directly into recipient bank accounts start in April and November. Recipients who have completed payment, registration and course selection procedures for the academic year for which the scholarship/financial aid is awarded.

Q13: How can I continue receiving the scholarship? If I do not receive any scholarships and financial aids in this academic year, can I apply in the next academic year?

A13: Yes, students who enrolled in undergraduate programs and have earned an average score of sixty-five or higher in courses during the previous academic year and a ranking in the top sixty percent of their class may apply for scholarships and financial aids. Students who enrolled in Master's or doctoral degree programs and have earned an average score of seventy-five or higher in courses during the previous academic year may **automatically reviewed by relevant FCU authorities.**
